- 2.4. The Company may conduct an introductory familiarization program / presentation when a new Independent Director is inducted into the Board of the Company.
- 2.5. The introductory familiarization program and the periodical technical sessions shall help the independent directors to understand the following:
 - a) Industry Overview and Business Model of the company
 - b) Business overview and an outline of Corporate Plan and Annual targets
 - c) Overview of Sales & Marketing
 - d) Introduction to product profile
 - e) Operations overview
 - f) Financial Performance and budget & control processes.
 - g) Familiarization on Statutory compliances as a Board Member including their roles, rights and responsibilities.

3. Program and Disclosure

- 3.1. This Policy shall be uploaded on the Company's website for public information and a web link for the same shall also be provided in the Annual Report of the Company.
- 3.2. Familiarization program will be conducted "as needed" basis during the Year.
- 3.3. As and when the familiarization program is conducted, details of the same will be disclosed on the website of the Company and a web link thereto shall also be given in the Annual Reports of the Company.
